

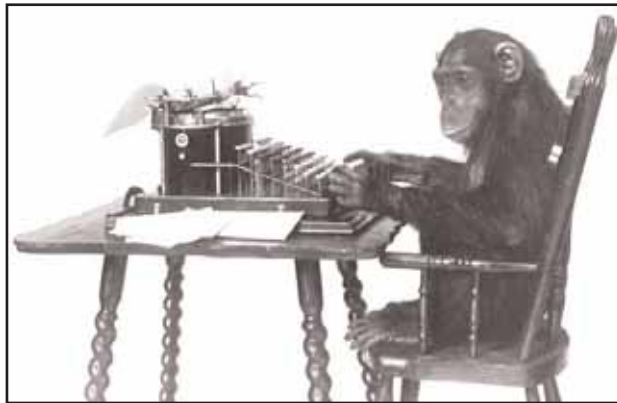
# Welcome to the LTLF fanzine

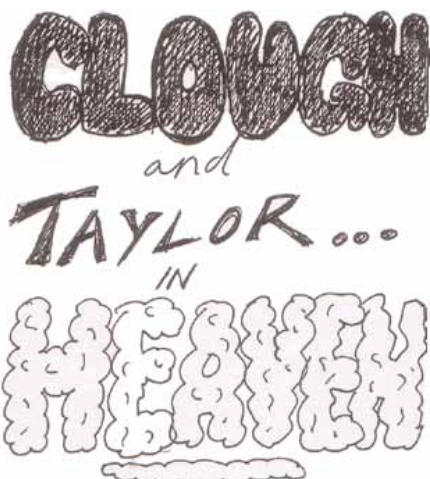
